Construction hours extension

Dear neighbour,

We are writing to notify you of some recent changes to construction work hours that were announced by the Planning and Public Spaces Minister Rob Stokes on 2 April 2020.

The Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020 is now in place and allows construction sites in NSW to operate on weekends and public holidays. You can view a copy of the Order by searching for Government Gazette No 68 on gazette.legislation.nsw.gov.au/.

This new order will make it easier for workers to abide by social distancing rules while keeping construction projects progressing by allowing building work to be spread across more days of the week.

The Walsh Bay Arts Precinct Redevelopment Project will comply with this order and extend the Saturday work hours that were originally 8am to 1pm, to 7am to 5pm. We are also intending to work on Sundays between 7am to 5pm as well as the public holiday days of the Easter Long Weekend.

We understand the potential impacts this may cause to our neighbours so we will take all feasible and reasonable measures to minimise noise, traffic and vibration impacts during these extended work hours.
