

Temporary Site Amenities

Why are site amenities needed?

With extremely limited space on the land based portion of the new Sydney Fish Market construction site, approval has been granted to construct a temporary facility within the grounds of the Sydney Secondary College, Blackwattle Bay Campus, to provide amenities for project workers.

What will be in the facilities and what is involved?

The site amenities will provide change rooms, lunchrooms, training rooms and bathroom facilities for on-site workers.

The temporary site amenities consist of double stacked site sheds located on a raised steel gantry. Workers will directly access the construction site via a raised

steel bridge located above the Glebe foreshore walk.

There will be no access between the facility and the school or adjacent public spaces, providing separation of the worksite and ensuring the safety of workers, students and the public.

When will the facility be established and dismantled?

Construction of the temporary site amenities will commence on 20th April 2022 and will take approximately three months to establish.

The facility will remain in place for the duration of the project, operating within project hours. It will be dismantled and removed on completion of the project.

Will there be local impacts?

The facility has been planned in close consultation with Sydney Secondary College, ensuring there will be minimal impact to students and existing staff parking will be retained.

During establishment of the facility **pedestrian access will be maintained**, with minor impacts at times along Bridge Road and the Glebe foreshore walk. Traffic control and temporary diversions will be utilised to maintain pedestrian access.

Once complete the facility will have negligible impact on pedestrians, traffic and cycle lanes.

Safety of the public, students and site workers will be of the highest priority at all times.
